**WOLFE CENTER RECOGNIZED FOR OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT
IN YOUTH TREATMENT & RECOVERY**

(Napa, CA) The Wolfe Center was chosen to receive the “Outstanding Achievement in Youth Treatment and Recovery” award from the County Alcohol and Drug Programs Administrators Association of California (CADPAC) at a conference awards banquet held on May 23rd in Sacramento. The Wolfe Center was the only youth treatment program recognized by the 58 California County Alcohol and Drug Administrators to receive this prestigious award. Sheila Daugherty, president of the board of directors, Claudia Solorio, program director, and Thomas Powers, former executive director of Wolfe Center received the award on Wednesday evening.

The Wolfe Center is the first-ever Napa County program devoted exclusively to treat teens with substance abuse problems. The treatment program targets youth whose involvement with alcohol or other drugs and co-occurring mental health issues is so severe that they need a more intensive outpatient intervention than is available from any other outpatient programs in Napa. The program includes the traditional treatment components of assessment, treatment planning, education, parental support/education and individual/group therapy. These services are delivered in a supportive environment that includes various recreational activities, breakfast and lunch meals, a computer laboratory, a music and recording studio, and other resources designed to catch and hold the interest of youth who are learning to live a clean and sober life. Currently, there are approximately 50 teenagers enrolled in the onsite program.
