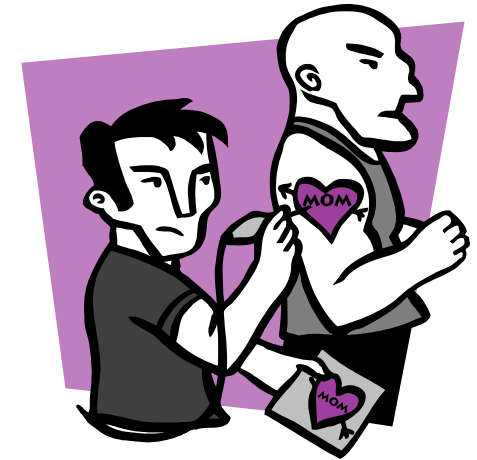

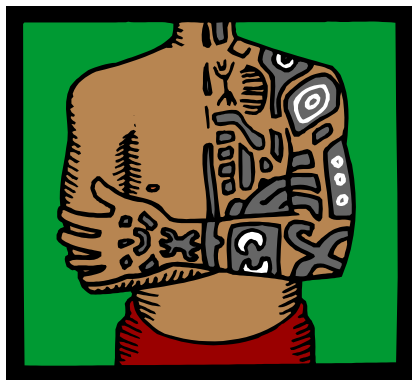


A TATTOO
REMOVAL
PROGRAM
FOR NAPA
COUNTY

Queen of the Valley Hospital in partnership with Napa County agencies is offering tattoo removal for the youth of our community.

To obtain low to no cost tattoo removal from volunteer Board Certified Plastic Surgeons, clients must agree to participate in the total program.

Tattoo's are removed from visible areas only— i.e. face, neck, hands, wrists, and forearms.



Program Participation

Includes:

-4 hours of community service for each treatment

-High School Diploma Program

-GED Program

-Career Planning

-Job Placement

-Counseling-

Individual/Group

Program Participation

Criteria:

-Must be a Napa County resident

-Age 13 –25

-Alcohol , Drug & Gang free

Tattoos are removed through a laser process that breaks up the pigment of the tattoo and causes it to fade over the course of multiple treatments.

This process may take from four to twelve treatments, depending on the size, quality and colors of the tattoo.

Treatment sessions are conducted every month for participants who fulfill the program requirements.
